

St Mark's Church of England Academy wins the Merton Drama Road Safety Competition

The St Mark's Academy Drama Enrichment Group WON this year's Merton Road Safety Drama Competition at Wimbledon High School on Thursday 10th June.

The competition is run every year and is part of Merton's drive to reduce the number of teenagers killed by road traffic accidents which are the biggest cause of teenage deaths in the UK. This year the students were given the heading "Don't let your friendship die on the road". The group of KS3 students were then given the task of devising their own piece of theatre under the guidance of Lucy Brown, Head of Drama. The judges unanimously voted St Mark's the winners over several other Performing Arts specialist schools and the top achieving independent school in the borough. The group was particularly praised for the creativity and originality of their work.
