Introduction to Football: Football, in its current form began in the middle of the 19th century. But different versions of the game existed much earlier and are a part of the football history.

5 rules

1. Only 11 players are allowed on the pitch at any one time, one of these must be a goal keeper.
2. Shin pads must be worn.
3. Players are not allowed to use their arm or hand to contact the ball.
4. A goal is scored when the ball is forced over the goal line.
5. Play restarts from where the ball left the field either as a goal kick, corner or throw in.
